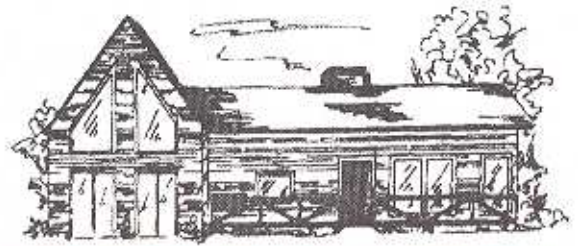

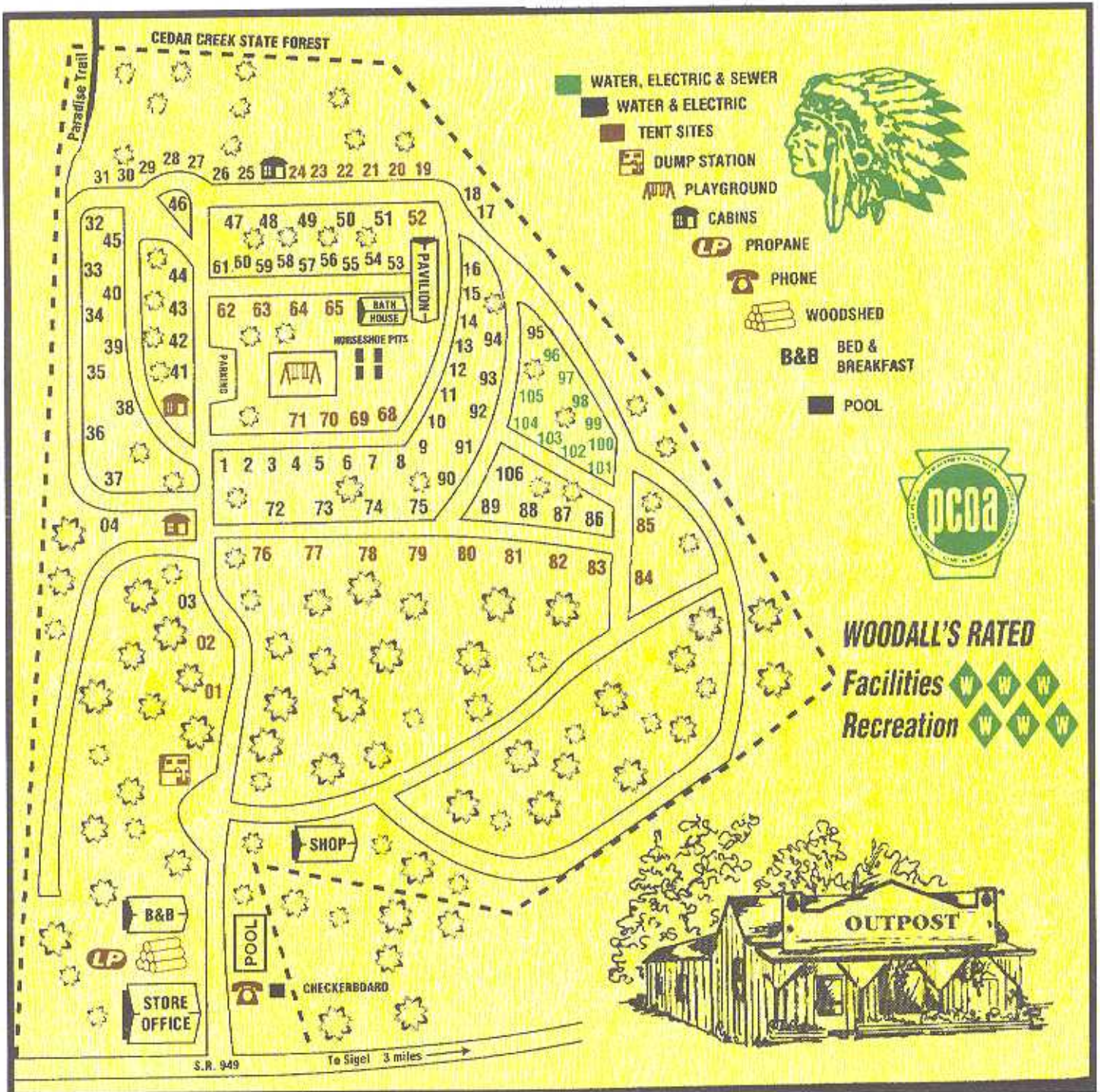

## RULES & REGULATIONS

### CAMPGROUND

- 1 Drive SLOW! Children at play. 10 MPH
- 2 Quiet hours between 11 pm & 8 am.
- 3 Alcohol must remain at your site or discreetly covered. No loud drunken behavior will be tolerated.
- 4 No bicycle riding after dark.
- 5 Fireworks, firecrackers and explosives are prohibited. Wooden sparklers are permitted with Adult supervision and disposed of in fire ring.
- 6 You may move your picnic table but please do not move your neighbors.
- 7 No trenching around tents.
- 8 In order to keep an adequate supply of quality water, do not wash vehicles or campers.
- 9 Electric heaters and air conditioners are an additional \$3.00 per day.
- 10 It is illegal to dump grey water from campers on the ground.
- 11 Please don't litter, use trash receptacles.
- 12 Please recycle cans. There is a trash can on the office porch.
- 13 All guests must register at office. \$3.00/day/guest. \$4.00/overnight/guest. Please explain this to your expected guests. They are not visiting you at home but a private facility maintained for the enjoyment of our paying guests. If you do not wish for your guests to be charged, please make arrangements at office.

- 14 Please do not leave garbage in firings.
- 15 Absolutely NO MOVING firings. There will be an immediate \$10.00 fine for moving firings.
- 16 Please take bagged garbage to dumpster. The dumpster is located near the security gate. Do not leave garbage at sites or in firings.
- 17 Do not cut, trim, or pound nails in trees. (Dead or Alive) This will result in an immediate Minimum \$100.00 fine!!!
- 18 Do NOT gather firewood, We cut, split and stack firewood as part of our family's income. You may bring your own firewood from home or purchase ours down at the store. It is OK to gather small twigs from the forest floor for kindling.

### RESTROOMS

Generally please help keep restroom neat and tidy. We work very hard to keep the restrooms cleaned and maintained for your comfort, unfortunately through past experience we must state a few rules which most of you don't need stated but for the few who do...

- 1 NO PETS in bathrooms.
- 2 Children may not play in bathrooms and small children must be supervised.
- 3 Parents, please instruct your children not to stand on the toilets or wad up paper towels or toilet paper and throw in toilets.

- 4 Please leave toilet paper, soaps and sponges which are provided for you in the restrooms so they are there for the next person!
- 5 Do not put camping garbage in bathroom trashcans.

### PLAYGROUND

- 1 Small children must be supervised.
- 2 Parents...please instruct children to NOT stand up on the merry-go-round.
- 3 No children on the playground after dark or before 8am.

### PETS

- 1 No pets in bathrooms.
- 2 Pets must be on a leash at all times.
- 3 You must clean up after your pet, bag it and dispose with your camp garbage.
- 4 Please do not leave for the day and leave your pet behind. This makes for a most unhappy camper doggie. (And maybe an unhappy camper neighbor.)
- 5 Do not use chains around trees to tie up your pets.

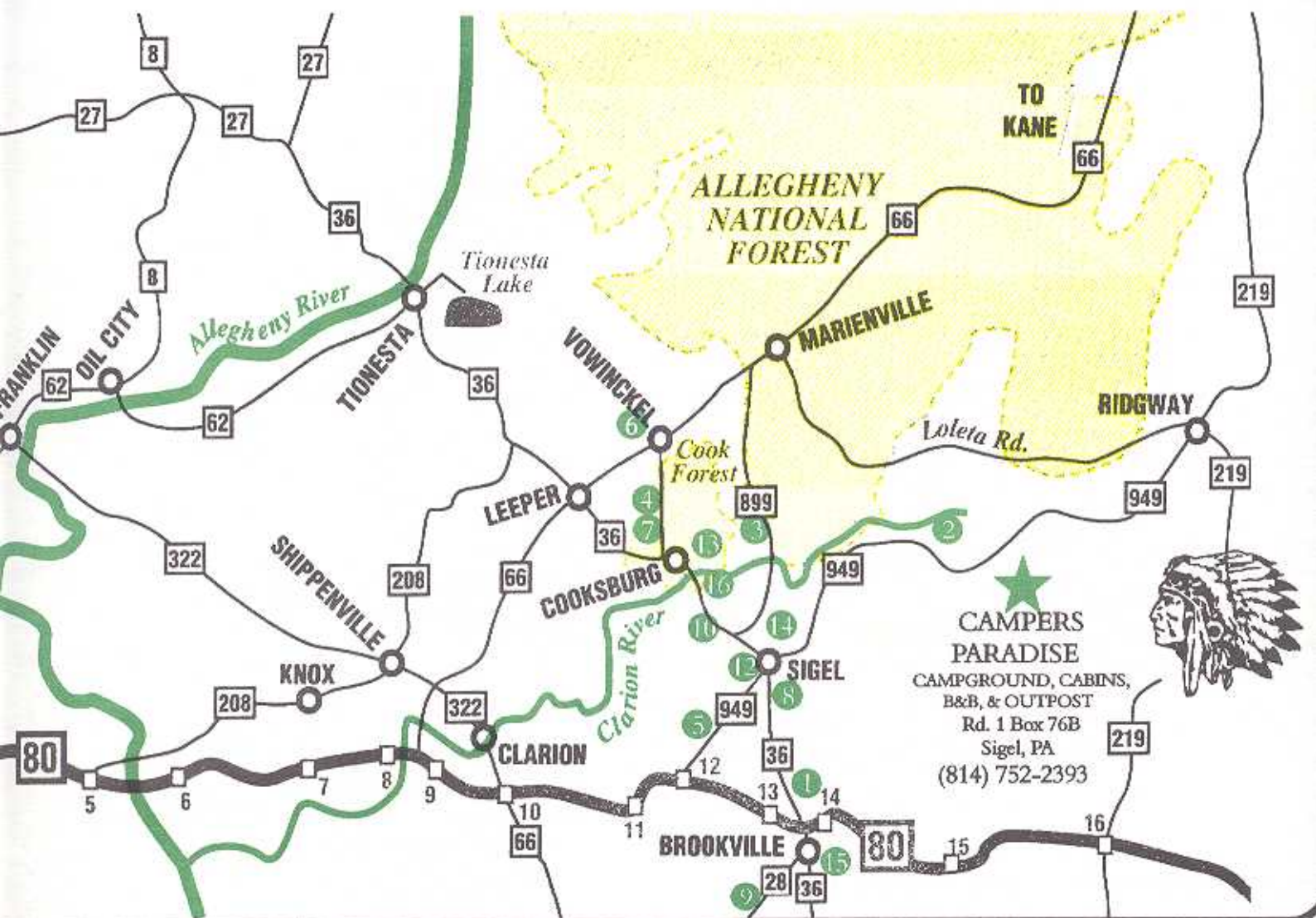
